The need for a common agenda to elevate the needs of Black Women in Europe to the forefront was confirmed during the Conference held in September 2003.

Furthermore, the difficulty of bringing our issues and needs to the forefront of policy making and political debate remains a vision on the distant horizon.

In an effort to revisit dialogues, which began more than a decade ago, the Meeting Place and Resource Center for Black Women in Zurich is organising a one day Follow-up Conference in Zurich, titled: **Strategising for a common Agenda**
